40 YEARS OF SERVICE



James (Jim) Normandy (written by CEO, Thomas Lydon)

For more than sixty-seven years, Lifespire's mission is to give persons with Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities a productive life and to be contributing members of society. We herald the values of stewardship, integrity, excellence, innovation and growth. The foundation of Lifespire's success is built upon our employees and their dedication to the service of people who seek our care and support. A special congratulations is due to Dr. James (Jim) Normandy for his 40+ Years of Service! Here at Lifespire, we believe in showing honor to those who have tested and stood the trials of life, fought the battles, and continue to press forward. Thank you, Dr. Normandy, for your years of service! Some of you may not know Jim Normandy, so I will give you a brief introduction and history:

- Dr. Normandy received his BS in '76 and MSW in '78 from Fordham University in the Bronx. While studying at Fordham, Jim assisted with Boy Scouts with special needs known as Troop 666.
- In 1977, on the heels of the Willowbrook Consent Decree, Lifespire was operating a "transitional residential model" on the grounds of Willowbrook known as the Plastik Residence. Jim began working at the Plastik Residence in 1977as a part time weekend relief staff.
- In 1978, Lifespire was awarded its first residence, the Herman Kaye Residence, which was originally located in Elmhurst. Jim was promoted to Residence Manager of Herman Kaye Residence.
- His clinical background coupled with his operational experience in residential services positioned Jim well as Lifespire expanded into day and vocational services when we took over another agency – M.E.N.D. This merger also brought Mary Lucas, Paul Oddo and Arthur Palevsky into the Lifespire fold.
- Jim held all of the OPWDD knowledge. Our founders Ida Rappaport, Harry Kamish, Sam Tocker and Mickey Marlib created Lifespire's advocacy and mission. Mary, Paul and Arthur had the vocational aspect of I/DD services well grounded.
- Jim had a vision to serve the most marginalized group of I/DD people: those who also had a diagnosis of mental illness. In 1982, he and Mary Lucas wrote a grant and created S.P.A.N. (Special Program for the Assessment of Need) to bridge the gap in services in the OPWDD world. This became our first foray into the mental health arena. In 1986, Jim became the Director of SPAN.
- In 1992, Jim Normandy established Lifespire's Article 16 clinic and became its director.
- In 1993, Lifespire expanded its services to include Medicaid Service Coordination.
- Because of his continuing contributions to Lifespire's growth, Jim was promoted to the position of Assistant Executive Director in 1996.
- In 1997, Jim received his DSW from Hunter University and was forever known as Dr. James Normandy.
- In the early 2000's he was promoted to Vice President. He currently still holds that title and is responsible for Day Service, SEMP, the Article 16, Community Habilitation and Products Plus.

Most people would be satisfied with a long distinguished work career but work does not define Jim. He is also an avid history buff! His knowledge is so extensive that he can distinguish different uniforms worn by branches of the American military from the time of the American Revolution to today.

He is a giant of a man standing six feet five inches with a distinct hardy laugh yet he has the heart of a monk. He is one of the kindest and gentlest souls you will meet. He shows kindness and compassion to everyone. Staff, families and persons served by Lifespire hold Jim in humble esteem.

I read this verse years ago -

"Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute. Speak up and judge fairly; defend the rights of the poor and needy"

Those lines immediately resonated with me because I knew such a person ... Jim. Please join me in congratulating Dr. James Normandy for his 40+ years of dedication and service to Lifespire and its mission!
